The Alex Danyliuk Scholarship Program: Deadline: July 31, 2018

The Alex Danyliuk Scholarship Program is designed to give financial assistance to members or the children of members up to the age of 22. Up to 2 scholarships will be awarded each year in the amount of \$1,100 total. The Scholarship Program is limited to applicants who have a primary residence in Manitoba and are passionate about pursuing a musical career. They must be enrolled in some form of formal music education programs in post-secondary institutions such as CMU, Universities or other regular musical instruction. Applicants should provide proof of enrollment in the music education program. Preference will be given to applicants who have not received the scholarship previously as well as those with the aim of serving FMC.
